ALL STUDENT FACEBOOK ACCOUNTS NO LONGER ALLOWED AT STS

Throughout last year and again this year, the Administration at St. Timothy's has witnessed the damaging misuse that Facebook has had on our junior high students. Legally, no one under the age of 13 can have a Facebook account, although many students do have one. At the request of this present administration, we are asking all parents and students to close all Facebook sites, owned by STS students. Not closing your account will result in suspension from school until the account is closed. Length of suspension is at the discretion of the Principal.
